**Another Source Named as Finalist in 2007 American Business AwardsSM

SEATTLE, Wash. (May 25, 2007) – Another Source, an employment referral service in Seattle, has been named a finalist in The 2007 American Business Awards.

Members of the Awards' board of distinguished judges and advisors and their staffs will select Stevie Award winners this week from among finalists. Finalists were chosen by business professionals nationwide during preliminary judging in April through early May. Nicknamed the Stevie for the Greek word “crowned,” the elegant Stevie trophy was designed by the same company that makes the Oscar and the Emmy.

“Being named a finalist in The American Business Awards is an important achievement,” said Michael Gallagher, founder and president of The Stevie Awards. “It means that independent business executives have agreed that the nominee is worthy of national recognition. We congratulate all of the finalists on their achievement and wish them well in the competition.”
